The Order of Architects and Consulting Engineers (OAI), established in march 1990 by the luxembourgish law of 13th December 1989, gathers **5 liberal professions**

- **architects**
- **interior architects**
- **consulting engineers**
- **urban designers and master planers**
- **landscape architects / landscape engineers.**

### A very dynamic and growing sector

Since 1990,

- the number of **architect offices established in Luxembourg** has more than **tripled (510 in 2019)**. To this number are added a further 149 occasional service providers representing 23% of the 659 architect offices operating in Luxembourg.
  - the number of **consulting engineer offices established in Luxembourg** has almost **quintupled (204 in 2019)**. To this number are added a further 53 occasional service providers representing 21% of the 257 consulting engineer offices operating in Luxembourg.
- These 691 offices established in Luxembourg **employ more than 5.000 people.**

### 3 OAI missions: legal, professional, cultural.

Beyond its missions as a legal body, as a professional organisation and as an institution of public interest, the OAI enhances the real dimension of its members' work at an economic, social, artistic and cultural level, to attain a sustainable, smart and high quality living environment.
