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ABOUT LYON

GA Paris presents the evolution of contemporary architecture over more than a century, from 1906 to 2012.

The urban community of LYON has 58 municipalities and covers 51 500 hectares in the heart of the Rhone-Alps second region of France, with just over 5 MM inhabitants. The population of Greater Lyon is more than 1.3 million people, 80% of the population in only 16% of the territory of the department. Lyon approaches the third millennium with a set of major projects that will strengthen the economic industrial and innovative sectors (biotechnology, digital images ...) and ensure the flow of traffic both to the city (airport, TGV, motorways), and outside the city (airport rapid transit downtown, extension and mesh networks tram and metro).

To be properly understood, contemporary architecture must be placed in the context of its era. The period leading from the start of the 20th century to the present day can be divided in 7 periods:

1901-1919: Electricity, the car and reinforced concrete fuelled dreams of revolutionary

architecture and a new form of town planning. In 1917, two years before the Bauhaus was founded ,**Tony Garnier** published his revolutionary blueprint for

an "Industrial city".

1920- 1944 Major social movements and the second World War shook France. It was the

time of the Spirit Nouveau magazine, marked by Le Corbusier and the

discovery of functionalism, the machine aesthetic and purism.

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ABOUT LYON

1945-1965:

France heals its wounds. Several areas of Lyons were destroyed in the war. This period saw the birth of the international Modern Movement as a result of urban growth, the industrial revolution, the shift from rural to urban and centralised planning. There was a huge need for housing and factories. Construction was industrialised and new districts were built.

Le Corbusier, Jacques Perrin-Fayolle, Auguste Murat and Alain Chomel.

1966- 1974:

The limit's of previous period's enthusiastic pursuit of development became apparent, as strident opposition emerged. Attempts were made to reconcile the "megastructures" appeared with the "human scale" to improve quality of life. **Zumbrunnen, Weckerlin, Provost & Zol.**

1975- 1989

Giving life meaning was the priority in this period. In seeking to convey greater sensitivity, architecture became more narrative. Individualism predominated. The mandatory design contests for public buildings created a spirit of competition which injected new life in architecture.

Bernard Zehrfuss, Mario Botta & Rene Gages.

1990-2016

Considerable progress were made in terms of materials and implementation. The issues of ecology and economy took a growing importance. There was a quest of new rationality. The city became conscious of the value of its public spaces and began to present them to their best advantage.

From 2005 an increasing number of projects addresing environmental issues have emerged. Finally, there has been a growing desire to imbue architectural and urban planing projects with a strong identity.

- 2011 Le Monolithe, MVRDV, a mix used urban block.

16|00 Musee de la Confluence by Coop Himelblau (interior visit confirmed)

When glass Crystal met stainless steel Cloud, the architecture of the musée des Confluences was born, inspired by the two converging bodies of water at its feet. Beneath its 33 metres of glasswork, the Crystal functions as an urban space: a space devoted to where the general public comes in and to the circulation of visitors, a place of encounter and exchange.

10|00 Guided visit to le Couvent Sainte-Marie de La Tourette from Le Corbusier.

La Tourette was built between 1953 and 1960 in Eveux (near Lyon) and is the last major work of Le Corbusier in France. The strength, the richness and the complexity of the masterpiece is so extraordinary that in 1986 it was chosen by French architects as the second most important modern architectural project, the Centre Pompidou in Paris designed by Piano and Rogers being number one

12|00 Transfer by bus to La Duchere. Visit the operation of La Duchere.

Located west of Lyon, in the 9th district, La Duchère was urbanized in emergency in the early 1960s, in response to a housing crisis in the city. Incarnation of modernity ... of the time, this great set of 5 500 homes had been weakened over the years. Result? Isolation, property devaluation, concentration of social housing and socio-economic fragility of the population.

 - The CNR Bureaux et Poste de Secours by Antoine Chomel in 1945.

- 17|30 Reception at the City-Hall of Lyon by Ms. Joelle Moliera international partnerships Project Manager and M Gilles BAUMA SCOT Director. Short presentation of the urban development of Lyon (to be organized and confirmed after the confirmation of the visit).

Les grands projets: Rives de Saône; Lyon Part-Dieu; Lyon Confluence; Carré de Soie; Gerland; La Duchère; Rue Garibaldi; Tunnel de la Croix-Rousse; Anneau bleu; L'Anneau des Sciences; Grand Stade; Pont Schuman.

Les projets urbains: Villeurbanne - Gratte-Ciel Nord Villeurbanne - Cours Emile-Zola; Le parc Blandan; Place des Jacobins; Place des Tapis; Passerelle sur le Rhône; Espace Mazagran; Projet Urbain Entrée Est; Le parc Blandan.

- 11|30 Visite of **Lyon Parc Auto** with Mr Francois Gindre, directeur de Lyon Parc Auto (to be organized and confirmed). Place des Celestins. Parking von Daniel Buren
- Interior visit at the **Opera of Lyon.**In 1993 Jean Nouvel won the competition to renovate the french style Oper from Lyon.
 Outside the opera house, Nouvel only kept the outer walls. He also dug new underground levels and added a semi-cylindrical dome that is used by dancers. On the opera house front wall, 8 muses have been kept in place (Uranie, the 9th one was removed to respect the symmetry of the building).

The urban project of **Carre the Soie** is the urban transformation of a vast sector of the center of the town, located on the towns of Villeurbanne and Vaulx-en-Velin.

Shopping center by Arte Charpentier. The façade is characterized by a double skin in which the outer skin is a wooden screen which undulates as "waves". A 6 meter high footbridge links a new public transport station with access to the site.

12|00 Transfer by metro and visit the **Gratte Ciel de Villeurbane**.

The Skyscraper of Villeurbanne celebrated its 70th anniversary in 2004.

This group of social housing, by its size and modernity, reminds us of a building from the '50s. It is easy to forget how in 1934 the Skyscraper was in forefront of progress, in both terms of architecture and town planning.

14|00 Lunch at a selected restaurant.

Quartier des Etats Unis (1919-35) by Tony Garnier.

In 1901, after extensive study of sociological and architectural problems, he began to formulate an elaborate solution to the perceived issues concerning urban design. His basic idea included t he separation of spaces by function through zoning into several categories: industrial, civic, r esidential, health related, and entertainment.

16|30 Transfer by metro.

Hangar des ersten Films: Pierre Colboc, Michel Cova und Didier Reppellin 1995. Renovation of the hangar where the first cinema film was filmed.

Visit to the former Tony Garnier's **E. Herriot hospital** renovation.

17|30 Back to the hotel.

Pick up by bus.

Transfer to the airport

18|30 Visit aéroport Saint Euxpery by Calatrava.

End of the visit.
